As the ACLL is nearing the completion of our 9<sup>th</sup> consecutive season, we pay tribute to all of those committed volunteers before us and to the community for the outpouring of support and generosity.

Without sponsors like you, it would not be possible to offer such a fun and rewarding program to the youth of Anderson County.

As many folks know, Little League International is the largest youth sports program in the world. We are a non-profit organization and are comprised of volunteers only.

Anderson County Little League is committed to affordably offer the game of baseball and participation in our program to every child in our community that is interested in playing. With your ongoing support, we are able to continuously improve our program and the facility that the City of Lawrenceburg has been so gracious to allow us to use.

In 2009 our league encompassed 290 participants. This past 2010 season we were able to include 409 participants (an increase of 41% from 2009) from ages 5-14 and look forward to our plans for next year that will include even more participants. We were able to play 246 games in 9 weeks. There were 96 coaches, over 130 paying members that committed to background investigations in order to volunteer their time, as well as numerous committee members, parents and grandparents that volunteered their time through out the season.

In addition to continuing our Fall League in 2010, we are planning to increase our number of participants from 20, in 2010, to even more in the Challenger Division – a division for children with special needs ages 7-18.

We are very thankful and remain committed to serving the children of Anderson County in hopes that they become admirable citizens with outstanding character and develop into model citizens as they mature.
